

Our Wednesday Lenten Series this year is part of a worldwide celebration of the 500th Anniversary of the Protestant Reformation. The series offers a look at one of the most prominent documents of the Reformation: Martin Luther's Small Catechism.

The Wednesday, March 29, service at Waldeck, starting at 6:30 p.m., (with meal to follow) is being led by Pastor Glenn Hohlt on *The Lord's Prayer*.

The Wednesday, April 5, service at MLLC (in the fellowship hall) starts at 6:30 p.m., and is conducted by Pastor Alan Kethan on Holy Communion. (Care Committee serves soup & sandwiches following the service).
