

Replacement of fluorescent ceiling lights in parlor with LED bulbs completed as first phase of update of church lighting. Second phase includes main hall, offices, and bathrooms approved pending installation; third phase will be Fellowship Hall, followed by MLLS wing. Replacement of ceiling fixtures in narthex, sanctuary, and sacristy with LED fixtures completed. LED floodlights installed in wall mounted can lights and floodlights in sanctuary.

Roof leak in storage closet: temp patch eliminates leaks during minor rain events, more severe events display some leakage. Long-term repair under investigation.

Fellowship Hall stained glass windows which are cracked are being evaluated. Partial cost of repair possibly from endowment fund.

Lifting jacks being fabricated for repair of loose pews in sanctuary.


