

for that day following worship. From Psalm 103:13 – "As a father has compassion for his children, so the Lord has compassion for those who fear him."




A reception honoring all graduates was held on May 20 following worship. Those honored:

The Texas-Louisiana Gulf Coast Synod Assembly was held on May 17-19 in Houston. Pastor David Tinker attended as a voting member. Recently-confirmed member, Miles Tinker, attended as an unofficially MLLC voting member (not registered by deadline, but was able to attend).

The guest presenter at the Assembly was Pastor Rich Melheim. He presented about FAITH5 (Faith Acts in the Home) is a simple set of nightly and weekly "enrichuals" with profound psychological, sociological, neurological, and theological gifts attached.

These are simple enough for a child to lead but deep enough

to turn every faith gathering into a seminary (seed bed). FAITH5 is sweeping across churches and seeping into the DNA of worship, education, and pastoral care from the US to Latvia to Ethiopia to India to Korea. The attendees enjoyed the theory, brain-science, systems theory and humor of FAITH5 founder, the Rev. Dr. Rich Melheim, an ELCA pastor in his 25th year with a specialized ministry call to enhance the lives of children, youths, families, and congregations across the globe.

As part of one of Pastor Melheim's presentations, he quoted our own Miles Tinker. Miles had been at a workshop about the FAITH5 Family Devotions program, and he shared various responses with the group. Pr. Melheim was glad to have the participation of a teen in this discussion, and shared Miles' perspective in one of his later presentations to the Assembly.

There were presentations about the upcoming 2018 National Youth Gathering in Houston, Hurricane Relief efforts, and other actions of the church together.

About the Gathering:

Every three years, 30,000 high school youths and their adult leaders from across the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America gather for a week of faith formation known as the ELCA Youth Gathering.

Through days spent in interactive learning, worship, Bible study, service and fellowship, young people grow in faith and are challenged and inspired to live their faith in their daily lives.

The theme for the 2018 ELCA Youth Gathering, "This Changes Everything." The primary scripture will be Ephesians 2:8- "For by grace you have been saved through faith, and this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God."

Grace is a foundational and distinctive piece of Lutheran faith. This gift, undeserved and freely given, changes lives and perspectives as people realize they are enough because of what Christ has done and are called into the world to serve their neighbor and share the good news.
