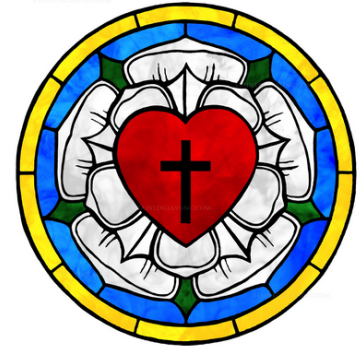

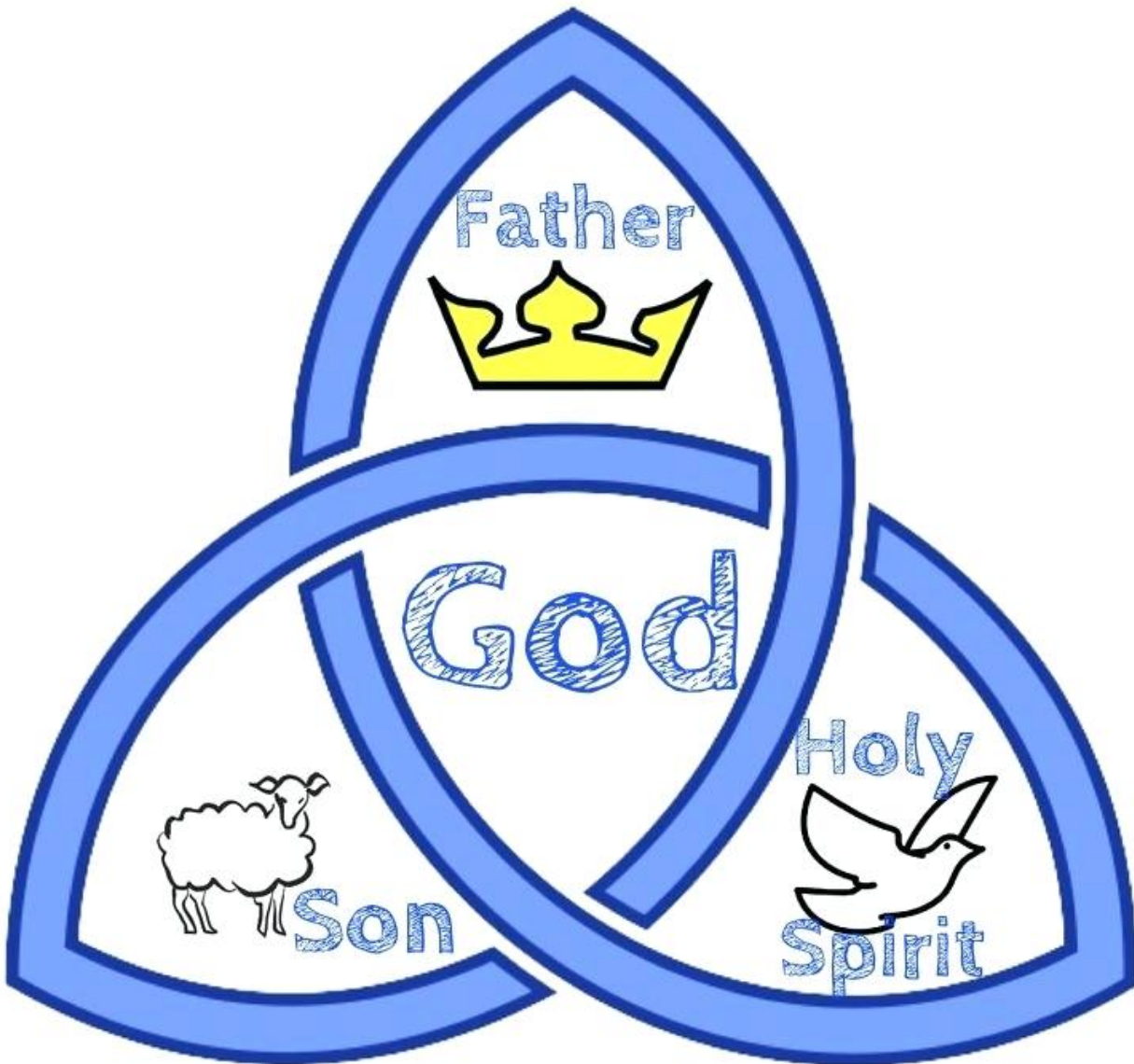

How Good Lord to be at Worship

How good it is to be together with Jesus and his people in worship and fellowship.

If you have been away from church for a week, I look forward to seeing you soon.

If you have been away from church for a month, I look forward to seeing you soon.

If you have been away from church for a season, I look forward to seeing you soon.

If you have been away from church for a year, I look forward to seeing you soon.

If you have been away from church for years, I look forward to seeing you soon.

This June, this Summer, let's get together with one another and with our Lord Jesus Christ for worship and fellowship. God loves us and calls us to gather.

This Summer, I invite you to strive toward being part of the good thing of worship and fellowship on a weekly basis. If you miss a week, work to get back on track the next week.

1) Plan your weekends around being able to attend worship. We have three worship opportunities each weekend – Saturdays at 6 p.m., and Sundays at 10:00 a.m. Remember that Waldeck Evangelical Lutheran Church – our partner congregation – offers worship at 8:00 a.m. each Sunday.

2) If you will be away for the weekend, plan ahead to worship at a local congregation where you will be. The ELCA web site has a search page to find a local Lutheran church where you are traveling: <http://www.elca.org/tools/FindACongregation>

If one is not available, seek out a church of another tradition. I always enjoy hearing from you when you return from vacations as you tell me about the churches you have visited while way.

3) Work on creating or improving Sabbath time practices. Carve out a day of rest, prayer, and study of God's Word, such as Sunday or Saturday. Consider putting aside handheld devices. Eat meals together as a household. Take a good nap. If your work is more sedentary, do something which gets you moving and outside.

4) Keep up with your regular offerings. Together we will still have expenses such as utilities and staffing throughout the summer. Make up missed offerings the next week you are at worship or send in your offering envelope by mail. You can also begin using the automated giving service. Items needed in Fabric Kits for LWR:

Two pieces of cotton or cotton-blend fabric (no knits or 100% polyester); fabric should have no stains or holes and be cut into pieces measuring: 2 1/4 yards of 60" wide fabric, or 3 yards of 44" wide fabric, or 4 yards of 36" wide fabric.

Two spools of neutral-colored, general-purpose thread, 250-300 yards each.

Fold thread and one piece of fabric inside second piece and tie with yarn, sturdy string, ribbon, or strip of fabric.

Summer Camp 2023 at Lutherhill – Younger youth

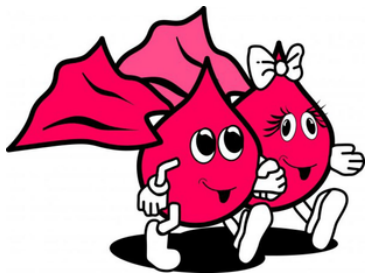


WELCA SALAD POT-LUCK SUPPER

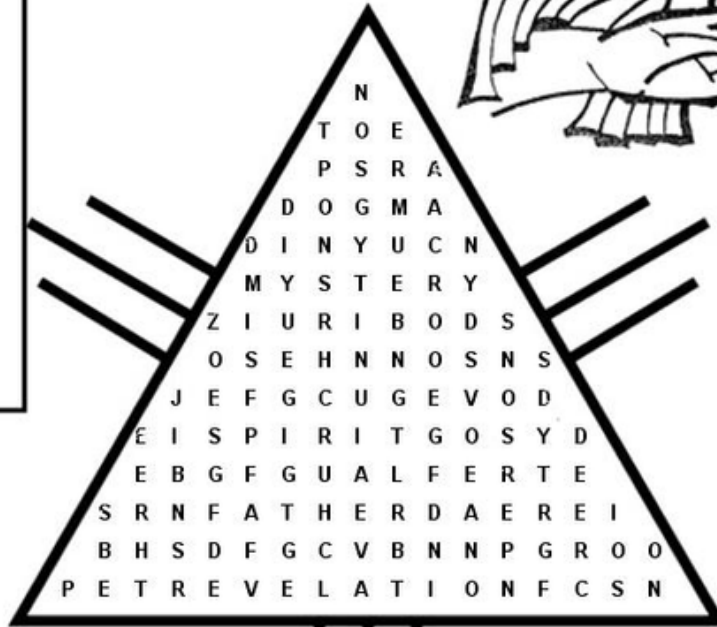
