

Bringing God's Love to the World By Pastor David Tinker

In the Edgar Allen Poe story, "The Masque of the Red Death," we hear about people in medieval times attempting to avoid the plague which was killing so many. They hole up in a castle. The world outside was unpleasant and potentially dangerous. Inside the castle, they felt secure from the problems of the world. While there these same people become focused on entertainment and pleasure. This does not end up well for them. The death of the plague in world enters their lives anyway.

This reminds me of what the Prophet Isaiah shares of God's Word in chapter 22. God is telling the people to get back on track with life. They are to repent, and to do the things he has always called the people to do, such as living out love for God and serving their neighbors. Their sin was neglecting the covenant God made with them. It was neglecting and harming the downtrodden in their community. Their continued sin and rebellion brought God's wrath. In response to the wrath, they turn even more inward. Those who are self-serving in the midst of the impending destruction of Jerusalem are saying, "Let us eat and drink, for tomorrow we die. (vs. 13)" In a sense, they are saying, let's retreat into the illusion of protection and revelry. Being self-focused ushed them into death.

My favorite rock song is from the early 1980s. It is a reminder to return to our God given calling. The song is, "Sunday, Bloody Sunday," by the Irish rock band, U2. It picks up on the line from Isaiah 22 and pushes it a step further. It notes how our use of the media and entertainment distract us from loving our neighbors. "And it's true we are immune; When fact is fiction and TV reality; And today the millions cry; We eat and drink while tomorrow they die."

In stressful times it is more common to pull back into self. We may not even notice what we are doing. Sometimes we try to exert control over one part of our life because there are things God calls us to renew our response of faithfulness to God and of love for our neighbors in need.

In light of this message of God in Isaiah, we see that it is not all about me. It is not all about you. Rather, it is about how, in response to God's love, we now love and serve others. It is about how we connect with the Lord. In our sin and fear, we sometimes get caught up in a shrinking circle of life. Founded on fear, we begin attempting to control whatever we can get our hands on. This fear-based focus on control ultimately directs our focus on ourselves. The people in the Poe story were basing their actions on fear. Fear begets greater fear of the world. This often leads to sin which neglects serving God, neighbor, and fellow believers. Sometimes it leads to a self-centered, pleasure-seeking life as challenged by Isaiah. Sometimes it leads to harming one another. Either way, it is not God's will for us.

As we move forward in God's will and way, let us focus on doing those things which strengthen faith and move us into the world in ministry. Daily prayer, weekly worship participation, daily Bible reading, will connect us with God. Serving others, encouraging and sharing faith, and giving generously will help us invest in others. Through this, we are bringing God's love to the world. We are living out God's will. We are stepping outside of ourselves for God's glory and to serve others. We are letting the perfect love of God cast out fear.
