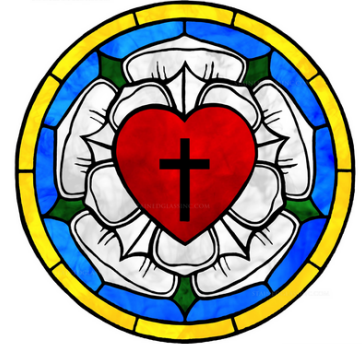


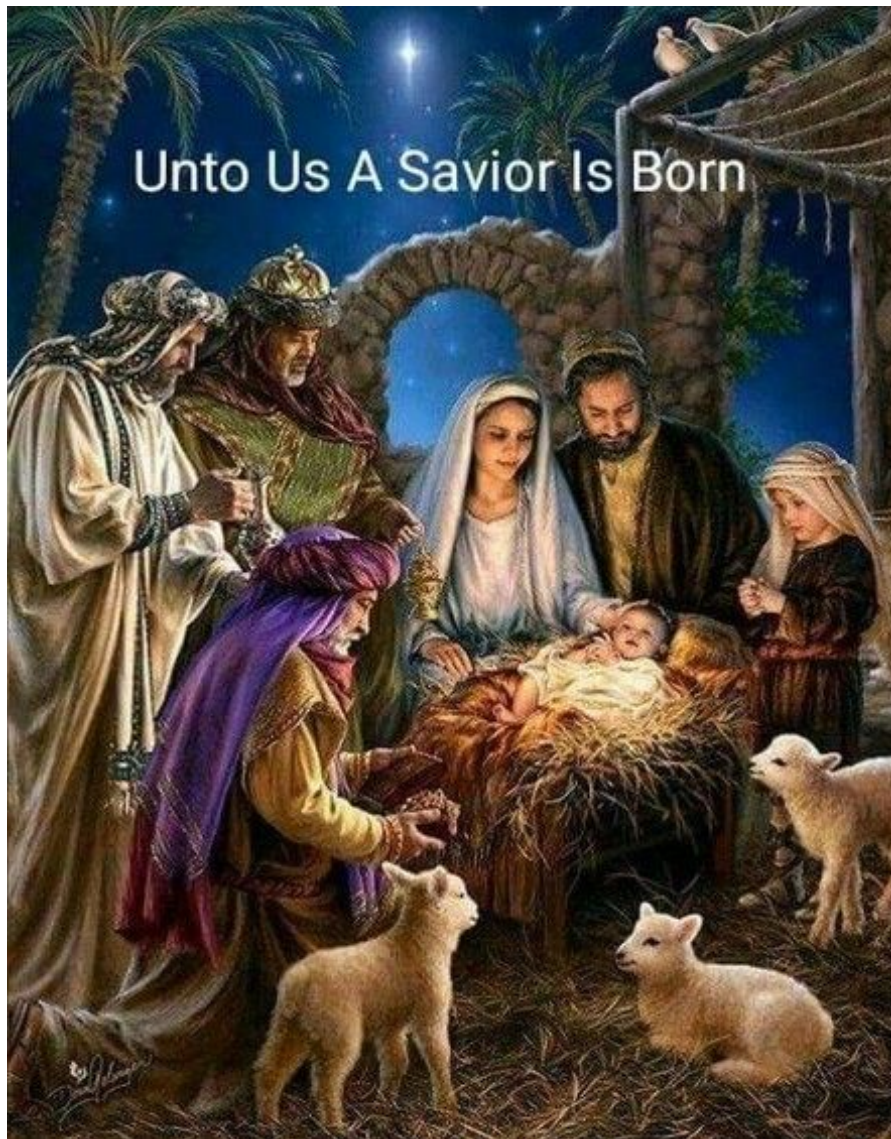

Getting Back with God and One Another by Pastor David J. Tinker

As we come to the end of the year, we often reflect on what is most important to us. As Christians, eventually we are stirred to reflect on the core of our faith. That core is our relationship with God through Jesus Christ. By what God has first done for us in Jesus, we are drawn to the Lord, forgiven of our sin, and brought into the fellowship of the baptized believers. Our connection with the Lord always includes our connection with one another. The Holy Spirit brings us together in the community, as Luther notes in the Small Catechism: "... (The Holy Spirit) calls, gathers, enlightens, and makes holy the whole Christian church on earth and keeps it with Jesus Christ in the one common, true faith."

Together as Christians we get to be more faithful, more joyful, and we can do more ministry than alone. As we get to the end of the year, and the beginning of the Church Year in Advent, we have the invitation to build up and reconnect with our fellow believers. For the building up of our ministry together, and to invest in your own faith, here are a few things you can do as we come to the end of the year.

End of Year Special Offerings

In response to God's Love and the ministry needs of our congregation, many choose to make a special, year-end offering. I invite you to consider this as we come close to the end of 2023. With God's help and our faithful giving, we can end the year with an abundance of financial resources as we head into 2024.

Regular Offerings

One of the core Christian disciplines is giving. A disciplined approach, such as weekly or monthly giving, helps us to respond to God's goodness in an ongoing manner. This also helps us keep continued support of the mission and ministry of our congregation. You can give by offerings on the weekend at worship or by mail.

Commitment to Worship Participation

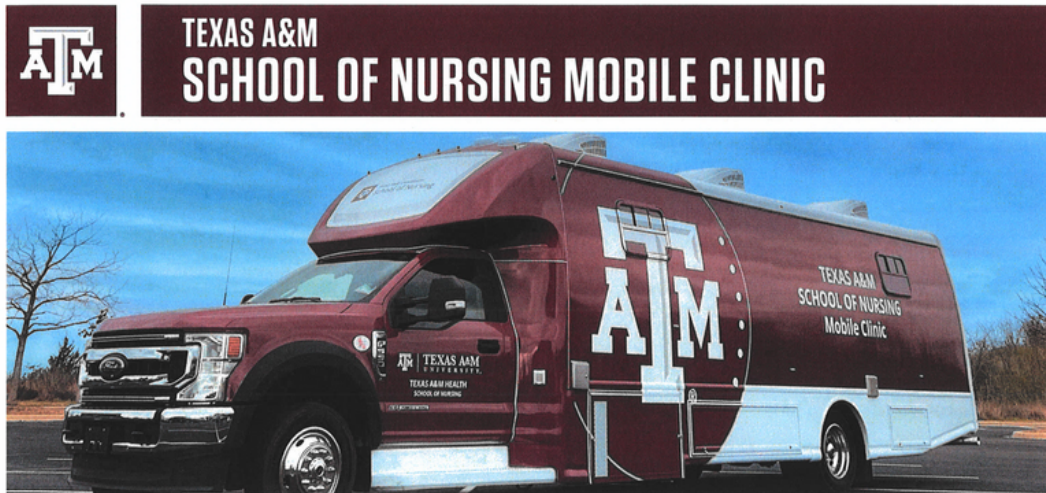
